

Math Times Two at Kensington Hilltop

This Spring, Kensington Hilltop School is excited to offer a Lunch Time Math Club for students interested in the world of numbers, shapes, and patterns. Jean Stenquist, a retired second through sixth grade teacher of long standing at Kensington, has set up a lunch time math club during both lunch periods on Mondays. She is pleased to see so many students interested in the first of three six-week sessions; at least 28 students come to Room 4 at each lunch period. At the end of a six-week session a new group of students will be invited to join the fun.

This doubles the extracurricular math programs now offered at Kensington Hilltop and bookends nicely with the after school Math Club run by Anne Forrest and Jean Stenquist in the Learning Center on Mondays. The after school program gives 3rd and 4th grade students the opportunity to get help with math homework, work on math skills on computers, and learn fun math games. At this time enrollment is full, but there will be a final session of the year starting at the end of March. Anne also works Wednesdays with 5th and 6th grade students for additional math support. This adds up to a lot of math opportunities which started with a well attended Family Math Night last October.
